483-ETFs, or Exchange-Traded Funds, can offer diversification and flexibility. But what are they, and how do they work? Let's simplify it.

487-ETFs trade like stocks but work like mutual funds. Instead of buying individual stocks, an ETF holds a mix of assets, reducing risk. For example, a technology ETF spreads your investment across multiple companies in the technology sector instead of just one.

488-Large financial institutions create and redeem ETF shares by exchanging them for the underlying assets. This helps keep ETF prices aligned with their actual value.

489-ETFs come in many types—some track stock indices, others focus on industries, bonds, commodities, or dividend stocks. This flexibility makes them a great tool for different investment goals.

493-Like any investment, ETFs have risks. Market changes, tracking errors or otherwise known as the extent to which the ETF's returns differ from an index, and liquidity issues can affect performance. That's why choosing the right ETFs for your strategy is key.
